To be considered, parents must submit an online application online to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment for evaluation at <u>www.online.factsmgt.com/aid.</u> FACTS representatives are available to guide parents through the application process and to answer any questions at 1-866-441-4637. Completed applications, including all supporting documentation such as tax forms are due March 1st. Applications that are submitted after that date will NOT be considered for assistance.



If a student has difficulty with an assignment, the parent is asked to communicate with the child's teacher so that guidance may be provided and additional time for completion will be given.
