THE BEGINNING OF ADVENT

Advent is the season of expectation of the coming of Christ and is somewhat penitential in tone. It is four weeks long, or slightly less, with the focus during the first two weeks on the final coming of Jesus as Lord and Judge. The final eight days of Advent give us the historical account of the birth of Jesus. The third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, is the Sunday on which the priest wears rose colored vestments that remind us to be joyful in our anticipation of the season.

During the Advent Season, our Church offers us many opportunities to grow in our love of the Lord. We encourage our families to participate in the devotions and services that will be offered by their parishes throughout the Advent Season.

As a school community of faith and academics, we will gather together on December 4th for an Advent Penance Service (with Individual Confessions to follow) at 12:30 p.m. On December 11th, our students will present their talents in prayerful music at our annual Christmas Program. Then, on December 13th, we will hold an Advent Prayer Service that will begin at 10:00 a.m. Finally, on December 20th, we will hold our last Advent Prayer Service at 10:00 a.m.

Classroom visits

This week I meet with grades 3, 4 and 5. We picked up the Red Ribbon Talk from our last visit. We talked about safety with medications. We discussed, in detail, some

tools and ideas to use as Refusal Skills. We gave examples of when these tools could be used, for example if a peer offered them a cigarette or pressured them into trying something. We discussed negative peer pressure. We discussed positive peer pressure too and how confidence can help a child say no as well as pressure a peer to make the right choice. We discussed using these same tools with regards to friends showing unkindness toward others. Parents, please carry on this conversation with your child.
