

With the colder temperatures coming in this weekend, we want to remind parents to dress their student(s) warmly. NO student will go out for recess without the proper attire.






# FROM THE NURSE:

Completed applications, including all supporting documentation such as tax forms, are due March 1st.

Applications that are submitted after that date will NOT be considered for assistance.
