Dear MBS Families,

During these difficult times that we all face as a school community, state and nation, please remember to be kind and respectful of others. We may not always agree with our neighbor, but we should always be tolerant.

It is wonderful to write that we have completed another successful week at MBS. Thank you to all the parents that have been doing wellness checks every morning and for understanding when we send home students, and siblings along with them, and for simply doing the right thing for all. We must all continue to mask, sanitize, social distance and continue to wash our hands regularly.

Just two reminders, please send your child in each day with a placemat. It is much more sanitary when eating at our desks, or outside on the picnic tables. Also, the gator-style masks are not as effective we, therefore ask that all students wear masks that have straps.

Last Thursday, October 1, we began to celebrate Mass over at St. John Neumann Church, thank you to Fr. Cocucci for opening his doors.

Restrictions are in place and we followed the guidelines for spacing. Both 7 th and 8 th grade participated. We will continue with different grades attending Mass individually, until restrictions are lifted.

In full transparency, we would like to communicate our notification policy for COVID cases in the school community. If an individual tests positive, we will notify you as soon as we are able. No identifying information will be given out regarding students or staff who may be sick or have tested positive for COVID-19. If an individual, either a staff member or student, is quarantined because s/he is a close exposure to a positive case, we will only notify the school community if that individual becomes positive, as close contacts do not pose any risk to the community and are being quarantined out of an abundance of caution to protect our entire community. We want to be clear that this is not to conceal information, rather to ensure that our community is safe, healthy, and prepared with actionable information. We care about every individual in our community and wish to de-stigmatize those in quarantine or ill and to promote positive connections in the school community.

Dr. DeAngelo, Superintendent of the Diocese of Wilmington, was here yesterday. He congratulated us on all that we are doing to maintain our safe environment and the consistent follow through.

We finished up Renaissance Testing this week. Results will go home next week.



Procedures to Return to MBS after Travel & Exposure to COVID-19

Traveling

- If you are traveling anywhere and you will be interacting with the general public, large gathering, or traveling to a state with a COVID-19 test positivity rate above 10%, a negative COVID-19 test result will be required for the person to return to MBS.
- 2) If you are traveling anywhere with your immediate family but not interacting with the general public or a large group of people, a negative COVID-19 test will not be required. Continue with the daily assessment and monitoring symptoms, social distancing, and wearing your mask.

Exposure and Symptoms of COVID-19

- If you have had a known exposure to someone with COVID-19, you must quarantine for 14 days and contact the school, and you will be advised on the next step.
- If students/staff need to be tested for COVID-19 due to symptoms or potential exposure, students/staff must stay home until the results are received. This includes siblings of students and for staff and immediate family members in the school.
- For students/staff who have had a positive COVID-19 test, quarantining for 10 days is required. Students/staff may return after the 10 days as long as they are symptom free.

Please read and keep the following attached form for your records.

If your student is sent home from school, you will receive the attached form. Please NOTE the box of symptoms for (1) symptom and (2) symptoms. Also note, the conditions for allowing students to return to school after being sent home. If student is sent home, the school nurse will go over all procedures.
