#### MANDATORY HEALTH FORMS

In preparation for the following school year 2021-2022, the Health Suite has information that may need to be updated or new forms that need to be completed. All forms can be found on the MBS website or in the Health Suite. www.mostblessedsacramentschool.com

- All students who need an anaphylaxis action plan due to a life-threatening allergy: <u>Must have an Anaphylaxis Action Plan form that needs to be filled out and signed by</u> <u>both the parent and the physician and an order for each medication that includes the</u> <u>entire school year. MBS will also need all rescue medications turned in at the same time</u> <u>as the forms. Do not send in the forms without the medication. MBS cannot supply any</u> <u>medications for any student.</u>
- All students who need any medication: A medication permission form must be filled out by the physician and signed by the parent. <u>A new form must be completed each</u> <u>school year.</u> (If your child is on more than one medication, each medication needs a form filled out by the physician every year.) No medication will be administered in school without a written prescription from the physician and a parent's signature.
  \*<u>All medication must be hand delivered by the parent to the nurse</u>. This includes both prescribed medication and over the counter medication.
- Any students entering Kindergarten and 4<sup>th</sup> Grade: Must have a physical examination form completed by a physician. The parent completes the top portion of the form. The form can be taken or faxed to your pediatrician if your child has had a well-check examination within the last year. If your child has a well-check scheduled in the summer, please take the form with you to be completed and turn it into the health suite before the beginning of the school year. These forms must be returned to the Health Suite before the new school year in order for the state to allow the students to continue at MBS.
- All students entering 7<sup>th</sup> Grade: Must have the Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines. Record of these must be given to the Health Suite before the school year begins in order to be allowed to continue attending MBS.
- All students who have received any immunizations this past year: Should provide an updated record to the Health Suite.
- All medication must be picked up at the end of the school year by the parent.


