From the Health Suite



Please remember that if your child tests positive for COVID over the Christmas break to email Nurse Lewis so she can stay up to date on current cases.

As we enter cold and flu season, please remember to email attendance@mbscs.org if your child will be absent for any reason. If your child is experiencing any COVID symptoms as defined by the Maryland Department of Health (fever of 100.4 or higher, sore throat, cough, difficulty breathing, diarrhea or vomiting, new onset of severe headache, or new loss of taste or smell), they will need proof of a negative COVID test result, or an alternate diagnosis from a doctor or PCP to explain their symptoms in order to return to school. If they have other symptoms of illness that don't qualify as COVID symptoms, then a doctor's note will be required after 3 days of absence for illness.

Children must be fever free for over 24 hours without the use of medication, and their symptoms improving, before returning to school. It is up to each and every one of us to help keep our students and staff healthy.
