The successful candidate must have a passion for Catholic Education and uphold the school's mission of fostering a faith filled, Christ centered environment. This opportunity is a part-time, 10-month teaching position.

Primary responsibilities:

- Plans for instruction with logically sequenced objectives, based on knowledge and skills in art, including but not limited to drawing, painting, and art history, while incorporating Catholic identity and faith.
- Provide instruction by which students develop aesthetic concepts and appreciations and the ability to make qualitative judgments about art.
- Instruct students in proper care and use of tools and equipment.
- Organize storage areas and control use of materials, equipment and tools to prevent loss or abuse, and to minimize time required for distribution and collection.
- Evaluate each student's performance and growth in knowledge and aesthetic understandings and prepare progress reports.
- Plan and present art displays and exhibitions designed to showcase students' work for the school and the community.
- Practice positive, consistent discipline in the management of the classroom.
- Collaborates with peers to enhance the work environment and support instructional planning.
- Demonstrates professionalism in conduct, demeanor, and work habits.
- Attend all teacher in-services, faculty and department meetings, and professional development and faith formation seminars.
- Participate in additional school-related activities, including but not limited to: Open House, Graduation, Back to School nights, Parent Conferences, and Fundraisers.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in appropriate subject area.
- Licensing and certification in Maryland or Delaware or willing to transfer license.
- Demonstrate commitment to the principles of Catholic Faith.
- Knowledge of application of best teaching practices.
- Proven to be detail-oriented and self-directed with the ability to work independently and with a team.
