The Media Specialist will maintain a diverse and current media collection (electronic and print) and facilitate student and staff use of the resources in the media center program. This opportunity is a part-time, 10-month teaching position with the possibility of moving into a full-time position.

Primary responsibilities:

- Implement a comprehensive instructional curriculum in library and technology for assigned grade levels that complements MBS's sequential and standardized curricular goals.
- Work collaboratively and individually to design, develop, and implement programs to encourage reading for enjoyment and for information.
- Develop and implement activities that motivate students to read, write, speak and listen for intrinsic satisfaction in learning.
- Collaborate with other educators to build and strengthen connections between student information and research needs, curricular content, learning outcomes and information resources.
- Model and implement standards of responsible use for information for print and technology.
- Provide continual assessment of student progress and maintain progress records.
- Supervise student activities with the classroom and other areas assigned, always enforcing elevated expectations for student behavior.
- Organize materials, resources and space to support learning.
- Communicate via phone, email, zoom, and in person with families regarding student academic progress.
- Attend all teacher in-services, faculty and department meetings, and professional development and faith formation seminars.
- Participate in additional school-related activities, including but not limited to: Open House, Graduation, Back to School nights, Parent Conferences, and Fundraisers.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in appropriate subject area or equivalent experience.
- Licensing and certification in Maryland or Delaware or willing to transfer license.
- Demonstrate commitment to the principles of Catholic Faith.
- Knowledge of application of best teaching practices.
