### From the Health Suite

With cold and flu season in full swing, please practice good hand washing habits with your children, remind them to cover their coughs and sneezes, and keep them home if they are experiencing flu-like symptoms. Our area is experiencing a Flu outbreak, and we are working diligently to keep our surfaces and our hands clean at school, but the Flu is proving to be quite contagious.

Please check your child for signs and symptoms of illness before sending them to school. A child who needs a medication for symptoms of illness likely needs to stay home and rest so that they can recover, and so that they don't spread their illness to those around them. Students must be at least 24 hours free from fever (without medication), vomiting and diarrhea, before returning to school. If they still have a persistent cough, then they are likely still contagious. Please do not send them back until their cough is getting better. When in doubt, please reach out to our school nurse or your child's primary health care provider for guidance. If your child will be absent for any reason, please remember to email <u>attendance@mbscs.org</u> with the expected dates of absence and the reason. After 3 days of absence for illness, we ask that your child get a doctor's note to return to school.
