
# **Dolphin Days**

If you are currently receiving tuition assistance or will need assistance for next school year this application MUST be completed. Please contact Mrs. Gunther you need help with the application.

**Re-registration Form/ Tuition Contract** went home today in the Thursday folders. This form is necessary for us to be able to plan for the next school year. Please return the completed form along with the appropriate fee to the office by February 2<sup>nd</sup>, to secure your spot in the class. Open enrollment begins on February 5<sup>th</sup>.

Please check your **FACTS** accounts. Many have overdue balances under the incidental accounts.

Autopay must be manually turned on.

All invoices issued prior to turning autopay on will still need to be paid manually. If you wish to have MBS turn on autopay for you, please send a request to <u>mbsfinance@mbscs.org</u>.

Failure to keep your FACTS account current could result in the loss of activities (i.e. sports, piano, extended day, bus etc.). Your FACTS account must be current in January to re-register for the 2024-2025 school year.


