For the month of May I will be discussing some topics from For The Sake of God's Children: Keeping Our Promises, Diocese of Wilmington program. 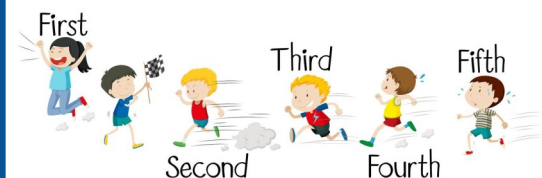
