They must fulfill other responsibilities in accordance with the MBS mission statement.

Primary responsibilities:

- Manage all processes related to the health and well-being of all MBS students.
- Provide appropriate nursing assessment and treat injuries and illnesses.
- Maintain student health records in accordance with Health Department of Maryland and the Catholic Diocese of Wilmington.
- Dispense and record required medication for students as prescribed.
- Coordinate care plans and special accommodations for students.
- Disseminate health information to administration, faculty, staff, students, and parents as appropriate and necessary.
- Maintain confidentiality in all areas of responsibility.
- Complete and file appropriate injury reports including notification to parents and administration.
- Attend in-services, faculty meetings, professional development, and faith formation seminars.
- Participate in additional school-related activities, including but not limited to: Open House, Graduation, Back to School nights, Parent Conferences, and Fundraisers.

Qualifications:

- Registered Nurse in Maryland or Delaware or be willing to transfer license.
- Demonstrate commitment to the principles of Catholic Faith.
- Knowledge of application of best nursing practices.
- Be reflective and accurately able to appraise his or her strengths and weaknesses.
- Proven to be detail-oriented and self-directed with the ability to work independently and with a team.
