

# Spanish Teacher- PreK-8<sup>th</sup>

- Assess student progress regularly and maintain accurate records.
- Communicate effectively with students, parents, and staff regarding student learning and progress.
- Collaborate with the Middle School team to enhance the work environment and support instructional planning for students.
- Demonstrate professionalism in conduct, demeanor, and work habits.
- Attend all teacher in-services, faculty, and team meetings, professional development, and faith formation seminars.
- Participate actively in school-related activities, including but not limited to: Graduation, Back to School Nights,
  Parent Conferences, and Fundraisers.
- Maintain a classroom environment that supports the dignity of each student and promotes respect, responsibility, and reverence.

- Bachelor's degree in Spanish, Education, or a related field
- Fluency in Spanish (spoken and written)
- A strong commitment to the Catholic mission of the school
- Ability to create a joyful, engaging classroom for a wide range of grade levels
- Successful background check and compliance with Safe Environment policies of the Diocese of Wilmington
- Proven to be detail-oriented and self-directed with the ability to work independently and with a team.
